### **Description of School**

St. Louis Community College is the largest community college district in Missouri and one of the largest in the United States. STLCC provides accessibility with four main campuses strategically located throughout the St. Louis Metropolitan area, from the very north in Ferguson at the Florissant Valley location, to the city's central corridor at Forest Park, to the southwest area of the county at the Meramec campus, to the burgeoning West County area at our Wildwood campus. STLCC offers 15 college-transfer and 90-plus career programs in the areas of art and design, business, civil and community service, engineering and technology, health and office professions; plus continuing education, developmental, and business/industrial training programs. STLCC also offers opportunities for high school students to start their college career early by taking dual enrollment and dual credit courses. More than one-half the households in the St. Louis area include at least one person who has attended STLCC. More than 80% of career and technical graduates employed in their fields or continue their education at four-year institutions within six months of graduation. Over the past two years, more than 1,700 STLCC students transferred to Missouri public/private four-year institutions; STLCC sends more transfer students to Missouri's four-year colleges/universities than any other college in the state.
