### **Description of School**

The University of Chicago is a private research institution located on a 215-acre green campus in the city of Chicago with approximately 6,000 undergraduate students. The school boasts a 6:1 student to faculty ratio with the majority of classes taught by faculty members in small discussion sections. Students begin their study in our core curriculum designed to teach them how to read, write, think, analyze, discuss across disciplines and conclude their studies by choosing from one of over 50 majors and 30 minors. While on campus, students live in one of fifty different houses on campus which are a microcosm of the college community with about 50 - 100 students from all years, majors, and backgrounds. Starting in their first year, students are also assigned a career adviser, and work with industry specialists to enhance their liberal arts education and gain experience in fields they are interested in which leads to 93% of our students graduate with jobs or enrollment in a graduate or professional school.
