### **Description of School**

The University of Kentucky is a large, public, research institution located in Lexington, KY, just 5 hours from St. Louis and is a straight shot down I-64 East. Lexington is the second largest city in Kentucky and is a great blend of both an urban and rural atmosphere. UK has just over 30,000 students total, with about 23,000 being undergraduates.
