### **Description of School**

The University of Tulsa (TU) is a small to mid-sized private, independent, comprehensive, doctoral-degree granting university grounded in the liberal arts. The University of Tulsa has four undergraduate colleges: Henry Kendall College of Arts and Sciences, Collins College of Business, College of Engineering and Natural Sciences, and College of Health Sciences. Out of the 3,500 undergraduate students at TU, 220 are from the St. Louis metro area from 44 different high schools. Fourteen of the currently enrolled undergraduate students at TU are from one of the four schools represented at the Four School College Fair. In addition, TU has 1,200 graduate and law school students. 62% of TU's undergraduate classes have fewer than 20 students and 36% have 20-49 students. Overall TU's average class size is 22 and the student to faculty ratio is 11:1. TU competes at the NCAA Division I level and is the smallest school to do so to include NCAA Division I-A football. Imagine having a big school with athletics all while having an intimate academic experience--the best of both worlds! Tulsa is just a six-hour drive from St. Louis or a one-hour direct flight with the airport just ten minutes from campus. The campus is also less than a 10-minute drive to downtown, to upscale shopping areas and to dining and entertainment districts. With 400,000 residents in the city and almost a million in the greater metro area, Tulsa offers TU students rich and wonderful opportunities for entertainment, festivals, arts and cultural experiences, recreation, internships, job opportunities and more. There are many activities happening on campus at The University of Tulsa, and it's a great perk also to have such a vibrant city as the backdrop for the TU community! TU has a full-time admission representative living in St. Louis to provide personal attention to prospective high school students from the St. Louis metropolitan area. In addition, there are active TU parent and alumni groups in St. Louis to enhance the TU community.
